By signing this application, you agree to the following for any cat/kitten you foster:

- ⇒ Cat Ladies Society will provide necessary medical care for your foster. If you have medical concerns at any time, contact a CLS manager. Do not take your foster to any vet without authorization from CLS. We cannot and will not reimburse you for any expenses incurred.
- ⇒ If at any time you are unable to care for your foster due to any emergency, it is essential that you provide CLS with as much advance notice as possible so an alternative foster home can be found. It is not acceptable to drop your foster off at the shelter without authorization.
- ⇒ At any point in time, CLS has the right to call your foster into the shelter for adoption or transfer. Failure to relinquish your foster will be considered an intent to adopt and all adoption fees will apply.
- ⇒ Cat Ladies Society will provide food/litter upon request. If you choose to purchase your own, CLS cannot reimburse you for expenses.
- ⇒ Periodically, your foster may need to return to the shelter for checkups, deworming, flea treatment, spay/neuter appointments, etc. You will be informed of these dates. It is your responsibility to transport your foster to/from the shelter.
- ⇒ If you should find an adoptive home on your own for your foster, you must contact CLS to handle the adoption. All prospective adopters must meet CLS standards and must come to the shelter to complete necessary paperwork and pay applicable adoption fees.
