2. My services are furnished without any employment-type benefits, including employment insurance programs, worker's compensation accrual in any form, vacations, or sick time.
3. I will familiarize myself and comply with CLS's policies and procedures applicable to Volunteers. In particular, I fully understand that CLS expects high standards of moral and ethical treatment of the animals under its care. I also understand that CLS expects high standards of respectful treatment of CLS clients, partners, volunteers, and staff. I agree to abide by these standards in my capacity as a Volunteer.
4. I will not represent CLS outside my immediate volunteer capacity. I understand that CLS designates specific volunteers to represent CLS to any media organizations.
5. I understand that CLS, without notice or hearing, may terminate my services as a Volunteer at any time, as deemed appropriate by CLS board.
6. I understand that the handling of animals and other Volunteer activities could result in injury to me or my personal property. I hereby release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless CLS and its directors, from any and all claims, causes of action, and demands of any nature, arising out of or in connection with my Volunteer activities on behalf of CLS.
7. Understanding that public relations is an important part of CLS, I hereby authorize CLS to use any photographs of me in its possession for public relations purposes.
